




# Supporting mental health professionals through interdisciplinary online professional development: eleven years of the MHPN webinar program in Australia

The Mental Health Professionals' Network (MHPN) has delivered webinars for professionals working in primary mental health care in Australia since 2010. This study investigated changes in engagement in and outcomes of MHPN webinars from 2010 to 2020.


## Survey respondent characteristics

From 53,468 webinar attendances across 75 webinars, **30,617 (57%)** attendees completed questionnaires that were collated and analysed. This sample was representative of webinar attendees.



## Key findings

Over the 11-year period, there was a steady increase in attendances per webinar, starting in 2010 with an average of 156 attendees and peaking in 2020 with an average of **1,919** attendees per webinar.



**92%**

of practitioners indicated that their work as a practitioner would improve as a result of attending the webinar.



**74%**

of practitioners indicated that the webinar they attended was entirely relevant to their practice.

**78%**

of practitioners indicated that the learning outcomes of the webinar they attended were 'entirely' met.
